Evie Morris



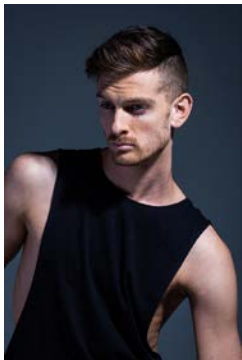

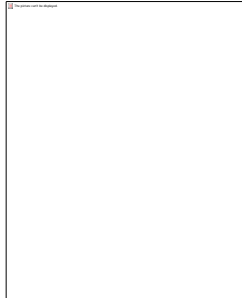
Pete Evans
