



The NSW Department of Education has an ongoing commitment to providing opportunities for talented students to participate in musical experiences outside of the normal school setting. This year's Music Camp will be a wonderful experience for students studying music both within and external to the school setting.

The South Coast Music Camp consists of a 4 day, 3 night residential camp at The Tops Conference Centre, Stanwell Tops commencing on Monday 23 September to Thursday 26 September 2019. Students are expected to attend the camp for its full duration.

The camp will provide large and small ensembles, individual tuition and performance opportunities for students during the camp. Ensembles will be coordinated and staffed by highly skilled and dedicated teachers from within the Department of Education supported by industry professionals.

Nominations are open to all primary and high school students in years 5 - 10 in NSW. We welcome players from any instrumental family, including voice. Please note that nominations will only be opened to non-Department of Education students if placements are available from the beginning of Term 3.

Applications are open to Department of Education students from Years 5 – 10 until Friday 6 July at a cost of \$450. If placements are not filled by this date, applications will also be opened to non-departmental students from Monday 6th July at a cost of \$500. DoE students who apply after this date will also be required to pay \$500. Please note you will need to pay this fee and provide your receipt number on your application form.

Positions will be offered on a first in basis. Please ensure you apply as soon as possible to secure your position in this year's camp!

Non DoE applications open:	Saturday 6 July 2019
All student nominations close:	Friday 2 August 2019
Camp dates:	Monday 23 – Thursday 26 September 2019

Camp costs:

For DoE students who apply and pay prior to Friday 5 July 2019:	\$450
DoE students (after 6 July)	\$500
Non DoE students	\$500

This cost includes accommodation, all meals, Camp T-shirt and music (including GST).

Travel to and from the camp is the responsibility of the student and their family.

Financial assistance may be available through your school. Please speak to your school music teacher or principal for advice.
